- OCT. 2 Depart for overnight flight to Dublin. (meal served on board)

- **OCT. 6** This morning we make the short journey to **Clonakilty** to visit the **Michael Collins Centre and Museum run by the Crowley Family.** Here you will learn about the great Irish Hero and see some amazing memorabilia. After our visit we head for the coast and the most southerly point of Ireland, **Mizen Head.** Here you can enjoy some spectacular scenery exploring on your own. - **OCT. 7** Today's journey takes us on a boat out to **Garnish Island.** This is a peaceful setting to walk around at your own pace and enjoy the gardens and many different plant varieties. This is a serenity day as our next stop is in the beautiful area of **Gougane Barra** situated in a scenic valley surrounded by the Shehy Mountains. Take some time to stroll around and visit the church and surrounding area. Our final destination is the busy little town of **Killarney.** Tonight we will enjoy **dinner** together in our hotel. **(B & D) Plaza Hotel, Killarney**
- **OCT. 8** Today is a **FREE day in Killarney.** There is plenty to see and do in this hustling and bustling town. Maybe a horse and buggy ride thru the National Park, maybe a round of golf, more shopping or just sit back and relax. Tonight we will enjoy **The Celtic Steps Show**. This is a great night of Traditional music, singing and dancing! **(B) Plaza Hotel, Killarney**
- **OCT. 9** Enjoy a bit of a leisurely morning before we head for the town of **Listowel**. Here we will stop at **John B. Keane's Pub**, home of the famous playwright. Hi son Billy will greet us with some local entertainment as we enjoy a pint together. It's then time to catch the **ferry to cross the River Shannon** on our way to the seaside town of **Kilkee**. Our hotel is right on the beach in this beautiful little town. After **dinner** tonight in the hotel it's time for another **session with Brendan in the pub**. **(B & D) Stella Maris Hotel, Kilkee**
- **OCT. 10** Enjoy another leisurely morning before we head out to some of the most spectacular scenery in Ireland. Liam will take you on a slow and magnificent drive out to **Loop Head** with plenty of stops along the way. It's back to Kilkee with the remainder of the day to relax and check out the town and meet the locals. **(B) Stella Maris Hotel**

One of the managers will greet us and give us the history of Athlone and Sean's Bar while you can enjoy a pint or maybe try some of Sean's very own whiskey. After our visit we'll make the short walk across the bridge and visit **Gertie Browns Pub** for a bite of lunch. It's then on to our final destination of Dublin for the last two nights. **(B L) Ashling Hotel, Dublin**

OCT. 12 Today is a **FREE Day** to explore Dublin and all it has to offer. Liam will give us many suggestions of places to visit. Tonight we will enjoy a **farewell dinner and Session** in our hotel. **(B D) Ashling Hotel, Dublin**

OCT. 13 Sadly our journey together has come to an end. Liam will take us to the airport in plenty of time for check in and duty free shopping. For those with very early flights we will help you with arrangements.
